

COVID-19 Preparedness Plan for Post-Secondary On-Site Classes:

All students will be asked to comply with these protocols throughout the duration of their course.

Pre-visit:

All students will be asked to monitor their symptoms for 2 weeks prior to arrival, including:

- Fever
 - participants are asked to do daily temperature checks and must have a temperature less than 100.4 degrees to attend
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- o Chills
- o Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

If any student exhibits any of the above symptoms in the 2 weeks prior to the course, they will not be permitted to attend the in-person class. They may attend remotely, or cancel their enrollment.

Rooming:

- Students will each have a private room and bathroom which includes 2 sinks, shower, and toilet
- Masks are required in corridors and public areas of the dormitory
- Rooms are thoroughly sanitized prior to your visit
- Students are expected to provide their own towels and bedding (twin bed) to reduce cross contamination
- Students will be asked to use ONLY the private bathroom assigned to them throughout the weekend

Meals:

- All meals will be individually packaged by trained kitchen staff
- Students will sit 6-8 ft apart while eating
- All tables will be wiped down with a bleach-based sanitizer before and after each meal
- Masks will be worn inside the dining hall except by those who are sitting and eating
- Students will be encouraged to minimize time in the dining hall
- Meals may be eaten outside if weather permits

Instruction:

- Students and instructors will wear masks at all times indoors and are encouraged to wear masks during outdoor learning
- Instruction will occur primarily outdoors (~85% of instructional time)
- Indoor instruction will be socially distanced and each student will be assigned a work area that they will use through the entire class. Some lectures may be pre-recorded to reduce indoor contact hours.
- Any necessary materials will be distributed to rooms prior to arrival to minimize the passing of materials during class



Handwashing/Hygiene

- Students will be asked to wash their hands before and after each class session, and before and after meals.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided during instructional time--students are encouraged to bring their own small supply of sanitizer
- Disinfecting wipes will be made available for students to sanitize their own indoor classroom area.

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
