What to Bring

Students and adults are responsible for bringing personal items and clothing appropriate for the season. 	Tennis or hiking shoes	Warm hat
	One pair of indoor-only shoes or slippers (for inside dorm and dining hall)	2 pairs of mittens (they are warmer than gloves)
	Warm jacket	Snow pants or snow suit
	Sweaters	Warm winter coat
	Changes of outer and under clothing	Long underwear
	Hat and gloves	Warm (wool) socks
	Several pairs of socks	Snow boots are required from November 1 - April 15
	Shoes, sandals or rubber boots to get wet for canoeing or aquatics

	Sleeping bag or sheets/blanket	Money for the gift store
