



Registration Instructions for Non-Carroll University Students

Non-Carroll University students may receive college credit for the *Wolves, Wildlife Tracking & Winter* course by completing a **Non-degree Application** with the following course information:

***All non-Carroll University students submitting the [Non-Degree Application](#) will automatically be billed for the \$420 course credit fee. This fee is in addition to the \$2,750 course fee paid to Osprey Wilds.**

Dropping Course: All students requesting to drop a course need to do so in writing through the Registrar's Office at Carroll University. Refunds are based on the postmark date if sent by mail or the date of delivery if brought in person. To receive a 100% refund, students must drop the course on or before January 1, 2027. All refunds are reduced by a 5% Administrative Fee.

Transcripts: Non-degree students registering for ANB302 may request an official [Carroll University transcript](#) upon completion of the course, provided a course grade has been submitted.
